Curriculum

The instructional program is designed to provide strong college preparation with Honors, Advanced Placement, and elective courses available in multiple disciplines, while at the same time developing an ability and willingness to defend the Christian faith from a Biblical worldview.

Dual Enrollment College Courses

CCS offers dual enrollment course opportunities at the school during the regular school day. CCS faculty members, as approved adjunct professors through local colleges/universities, teach these courses as part of their regular teaching schedule. Students take the course at CCS as one of their course selections. They receive both CCS credits and college credits at the conclusion of the course.

iPad/Chromebook Program And Technology

CCS cutting-edge iPad and Chromebook program provides juniors, seniors, and faculty members with individual tablets. We are also equipped with wireless internet service and a state-of-the-art computer lab. Many classrooms are equipped with Mimio projectors, wireless adapters, and SMARTboards.

Naviance Family Connection

Family Connection is a comprehensive website that CCS utilizes to help students make decisions about colleges, scholarships and careers. It allows families to streamline college applications, get involved in the planning/advising process, and research careers and available scholarships. Family Connection is linked with Naviance Succeed, a service that is used in our guidance office to track and analyze data about college and career plans, and provides up-to-date information that is specific to our school.

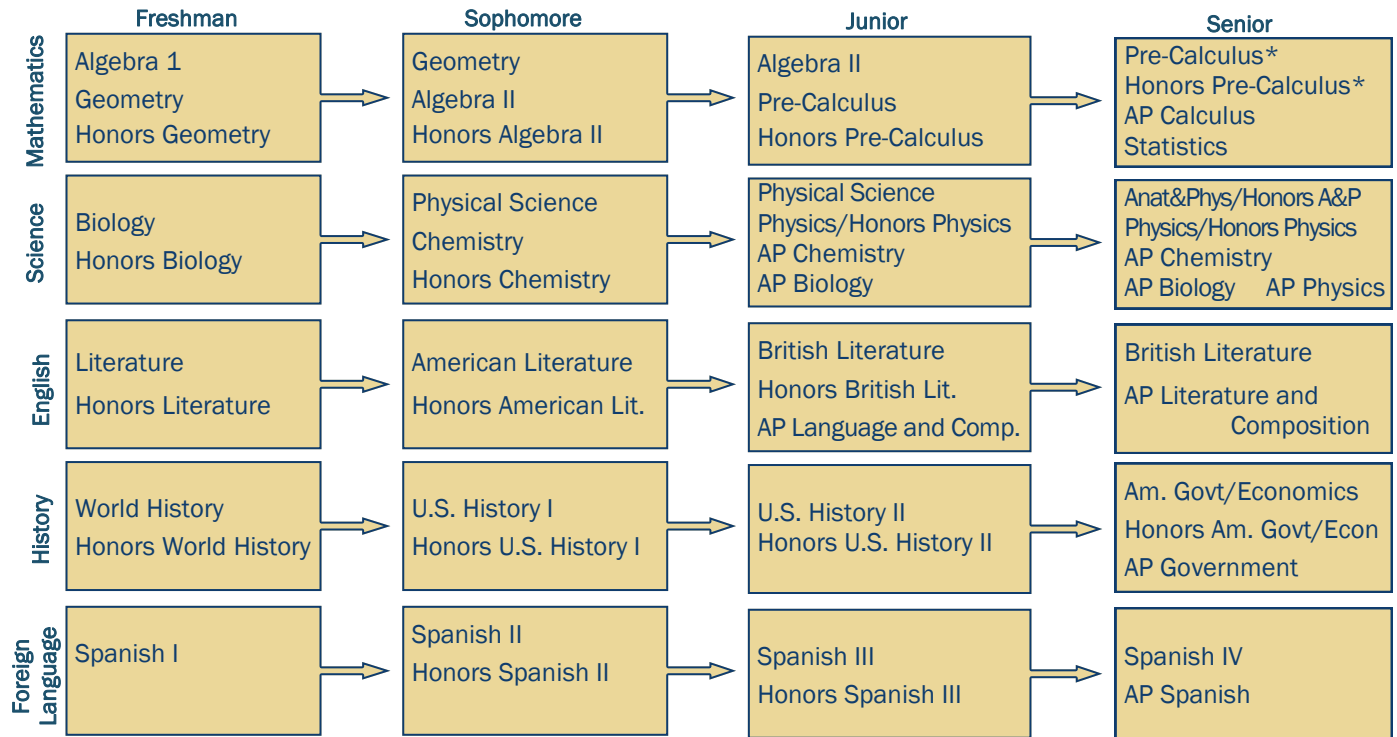

SAT SCORING

The SAT scores for CCS students exceed the national average, with scores as high as 2110 (highest possible 2400) which, according to College Board, is associated with a high likelihood of college success.

ACT SCORING

The average ACT composite score for CCS students is 28, with high scores of 29 (highest possible: 36). High ACT scores included a 34 (English), 28 (Math), 31 (Reading), and 27 (Science).

SAT PREPARATION

CCS provides essential SAT preparation for every student as part of the core curriculum. Additionally, every student in grades 9-11 will take the PSAT and students in grades 10 and 11 participate in required SAT preparation classes.
